Understanding Young Child Sexual Abuse

Young child sexual abuse is alarmingly prevalent, the impacts are profound, and our systems are underprepared to address the problem. Key barriers which impede our ability to address the issue include: believing that young children can be sexually abused, misunderstanding the nature of early childhood memory, lack of knowledge and skill interviewing children under five, and lack of collaboration across the mental health, legal, and child welfare systems.
