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

FAST Forward/Early Childhood Wraparound

- High-Fidelity Wraparound
- NH Wraparound Model

Utilizes Evidenced-Based Assessment and Outcome Measures

Family Peer Support Services (NAMI NH)

- Lived Experience and Empowerment of Family voice
- Comprehensive model with fully developed competencies

Youth Peer Support Services (Youth MOVE)

- Lived Experience and Empowerment of Family voice
- Comprehensive model with fully developed competencies

Customizable Goods and Services

Service Provider Development

Eligibility Criteria:

Children ages 0 through 5 and their caregivers

Children that have an identified concern, serious emotional disturbance, mental health diagnosis, developmental diagnosis

Children that are Medicaid eligible

Children that are at risk of developing concerns due to:

- Caregiver with Severe and Persistent Mental illness
- Caregiver with Substance Use Disorder
- Caregiver in recovery
- Concerns for abuse/neglect
- Family is multi-systems involved
